We all agree that the best we can give children and young people, is a public y education with quality and with equity. Once again, our union has gained favorable response to the demands of teachers:

- SEP agrees to make a thorough review of teacher evaluation.
- Teacher evaluation will be comprehensive, contextualized and educational, without penalties or punitive vision, respecting the dignity and professional standing of teachers.
- In response to the demands of teachers, SEP is committed to ensure the quality, equity, relevance and free provision of training programs and professional development. Clearly, this is a state obligation.
- Normal Schools will be strengthened to ensure quality initial training and remain the privileged space for teacher training.
- The expansion of the day in the new school calendar will fully respect the rights of teachers.
- SEP has pledged 50 billion pesos to dignify educational spaces, and to provide connectivity with equity.
- Teacher Career will be paid as has always been done.
- No later than August 16<sup>th</sup>, all arrears of wages, incentives and regularization of places will be covered.

With this response, we reaffirm that education legislation does not affect any vested rights.
